



## Focus on Publishing Software now runs on Macs

Focus on Publishing Software (software that brings you advanced Accounting modules, integrated with modules for Royalties, Rights, Marketing, Cataloguing, ONIX bibliography, EDI, Batch.co.uk support, Production and scheduling, Stock/Consignment control and Job Costing) can now be run from a Macintosh.

**If you are a MAC user, read on....**

### **See How It Works!**

Macs running OS X version 10.2.8 or later, using the Microsoft Apple Remote Desktop feature can now access any Mac or a PC running Windows XP remotely and take control of it over the network. This feature lets you run the Focus on Publishing system and SQL Server.

### **System Requirements**

#### **Workstations**

Macintosh computer with PowerPC G3, G4, or G5 processors; Xserve or Xserve G5, running Mac OS X v10.2.8 or later with ethernet network connection can be used as workstation.

#### **Server**

The server has to be PC-based. Focus on Publishing and SQL will be installed on this PC-based server.

#### Number of Users

If more than one concurrent user is required to use Focus on Publishing, then you need a PC running Windows Server 2003, with terminal server licensing (not small business server)

But if only a single user is required to use Focus on Publishing, then a PC running windows XP professional will do.

#### **Virtual PC**

**Note:** Use of Microsoft® Virtual PC for Mac is not recommended, as it is too expensive and is very slow in operation.
